STEEP	having a sharp slant or slope
RIPE	fully grown and ready to eat
DEW	little drops of water that collect at night on grass, plants, and other cool surfaces
NIBBLE	to eat in small bites
SIFT	to separate or remove by using a sieve
TRUDGE	to walk slowly and heavily because you are tired
COAST	to move without effort or energy
HUMMING	vibrating, low sound
PAVEMENT	a hard surface for a driveway, sidewalk, or road
GLIDER	a chair or seat that glides back and forth
SPUTTER	to make a series of popping or spitting noises
FERNS	a family of plants with large green leaves shaped like feathers
